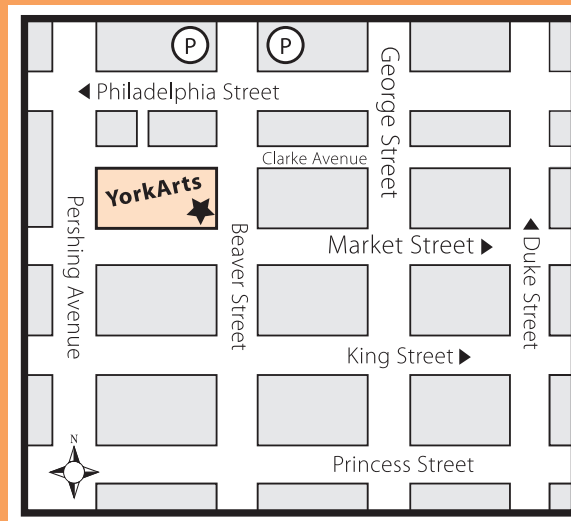

ABOUT ARTS DISCOVERY CAMPS

Arts Discovery Camps are for 5-17 year olds interested in having fun while participating in a creative experience. Camps will take place at YorkArts located at 10 North Beaver Street in the Cultural District of York. The campers will be provided supplies, a light snack, and may walk to local areas downtown. All camps will conclude with an exhibition of the participants' works. A minimum of 8 participants is needed for camp to be held.



MINI MASTERS

Little artists will learn about well known artists of the world while exploring a variety of techniques such as drawing and painting.

\$80 (Ages 5-8) June 18-22; 10-11:30 am

DRAWING AND PAINTING

Develop knowledge of the fundamentals of art while creating still lifes, figure drawings, and abstract paintings. Explore various media including charcoal, pastel, acrylic paint and colored pencil.

\$120 (Ages 8-13) June 18-22; 8:30-11:30 am

MOSAIC MADNESS

Learn the history of this age-old art, recycle broken pieces and create your own unique designs. Basic safety techniques and use of simple tools will be demonstrated.



Note: For personal pizzazz, bring broken bowls and plates with you to camp.

ART AROUND THE WORLD

Journey with us around the world, stopping to learn about different cultures. Some of our stops include China, India and Australia. Various art mediums will be introduced in this camp.

PETITE PICASSOS

Young artists learn to express themselves through drawing, painting, printmaking and sculpture! Students will be encouraged to create what they see and put their own style and feelings on paper.

ART COLLEGE PREP

For college-bound high school students looking to add an artistic portfolio to their college applications. Students create new works in new media and prepare older works for digital documentation. Instruction covers

drawing techniques and fundamental design principles. All students receive a final review of their work and additional guidance on how to build a strong portfolio.

CLAY CAMP 1

Students work in hand building techniques and spend time working on the potter's wheel. Learn how to wedge clay, center and form shapes on the pottery wheel, trim and finish your work with colorful glaze.

CLAY CAMP 2

Intermediate and advanced students design their own projects in a direction of their choosing. Expand your knowledge of wheel throwing, hand building, and sculpture. *Clay 1 is required before taking this camp.*

MIXED MEDIA ART

Fun art-making activities inspire your budding artist to create their own masterpieces with exposure to a wide variety of arts media such as: drawing, fiber-art, sculpture and collage.

THE ART OF SCULPTURE

Learn to use a variety of mediums including wire, plaster, and clay to create both abstract and representational works meant to be seen in the round.

ASPERGER'S ART CAMP

Students with Asperger's Syndrome explore communication, sight, and touch by using elements of art to invoke discipline and focus, as well as personal expression.
